M	Creator (Author)	dc:creator	An entity primarily responsible for making the resource. Examples include a person, organization, or a service. This may be the name of the author, artist, playwright, composer, choreographer, photographer, designer or poet.	String. Typically a name will be used.
M	Date	dc:date	Date the resource was created, published or made available to a larger audience.	Cover Date, use format yyyy-mm-dd
M	Description	dc:description	An account of the content or resource. Description may include but is not limited to: an abstract, a table of contents, a graphical representation or a free text account of the resource.	String
M	File Name		Label given to a file that contains the content. File name is not the same as Title.	String
M	Format	dc:format	File format of the resource, physical medium or dimensions of the resource. Recommended best practice is to use a controlled vocabulary such as the list of Internet Media Types (MIME).	String conforming to Internet MIME type extensions (e.g. application/pdf).
M	Identifier	dc:identifier	An unambiguous reference to the resource within a given context.	Can be system assigned or assigned locally
M	Title	dc:title	A name given to the resource, and by which it is formally known.	String

C	Season	dc:coverage temporal	A particular period of time within which shows are presented.	Date Range Format
C	Production Lifecycle Phase	dc:coverage temporal	Predefined lifecycle phase of the production associated with this item.	Values come from CATT taxonomy
C	Production Name	catt:prod.name	Names of productions mounted by a performing arts organization; variation of Title.	String
C	Production Type/Genre	catt:prod.type	The style or genre of the production.	Values come from CATT taxonomy
C	Venue	dc:coverage spatial	Name or type of theatre or space where the performance occurred	Values come from CATT taxonomy; supplement locally

O	Access Control	dcterms:accessRights	Type of access restriction to the content	Values come from CATT taxonomy; default is Public
O	Audience	dcterms:audience	A class of entity for whom the resource is intended or useful.	Values come from CATT taxonomy
O	Content Type	dc:type	The nature or genre of the content of the resource. Recommended best practice is to use a controlled vocabulary.	Values come from CATT taxonomy
O	Contributor	dc:contributor	An entity responsible for making contributions to the resource.	String. Typically a name will be used.
O	Keywords	dc:keywords	Descriptors for the content for which no equivalent exists in any of the controlled vocabularies.	String
O	Locations	dc:coverage spatial	Places where productions take place.	Values come from industry controlled vocabularies such as GeoNames or Getty TGN
O	Publisher	dc:publisher	An entity responsible for making the resource available.	Values come from CATT taxonomy Organization; may be supplemented locally
O	Rights	dc:rights	Information about rights held in and over the resource.	String. Usually includes a statement about intellectual property rights.
O	Role	catt:role	Names of vocational or technical specialists that are relevant to the content of the resource.	Values come from taxonomy: CATT - some values come from union contracts

C	Document State	catt:docstate	Current status of item.	Values come from CATT taxonomy
C	Revision/Version	catt:rev	Number or letter that identifies the unique document version.	Assigned locally by the creator.
